BLACK CANYON QUILT SHOW GENERAL RULES 2011 Revised

Entry forms must be submitted to: Black Canyon Quilt Show, INC., PO Box 2053, Montrose, CO 81402 by **June 1, 2012**. Attach a photo of your quilt to the back of your entry form. **(The quilt does not have to be finished in the picture. Photos will be used to help with planning a pleasing color arrangement prior to the show.)**

There is a limit of 3 quilts per person, and only one per category. This limit does not include the Challenge quilt category.

Quilts in the 100, 200, 300 and 400 categories must have a 4" hanging sleeve. The sleeve should be at the top of your quilt. One method of making a hanging sleeve is attached.

All quilts must be labeled. A 4" label should be in the lower left hand corner (when looking at the back of the quilt). It must contain the entry number, name of quilt, name, address, phone number of entrant. The entry number will be assigned as the entries are received. You will be notified of the number via e-mail or by phone.

Each quilt must be submitted by July 1st in an individual, fabric bag that is labeled with the same information as above. We recommend using a pillowcase for the bag. The label should be on a 4" x 4" piece of muslin.

Your quilts may be delivered to your guild's Black Canyon Guild Show representative at your last guild meeting before the July 1 due date. Friendship Guild, Lois Sackmann; San Juan Quilters, Carolyn Ray; Columbine Quilters, Kathy Huerta. Contact Lois Sackmann for other arrangements at 252-3494.

Liability insurance is the sole responsibility of each quilt owner. Black Canyon Quilt Show, Inc. does not assume liability for loss or damage of any nature to your quilt. The sponsors of the Black Canyon Quilt Show will handle your quilt with the utmost care.

Quilts will be released from the show between 5:00 and 5:30 p.m. on Sunday, July 10th only. (Signature of the person picking up the quilt is required during check out.)

CATEGORIES

- 100 Large Pieced, any one side of the quilt is greater than 72"
- 200 Medium Pieced, the longest side of the quilt is less than 72" and greater than 42"
- 300 Large Appliquéd, any one side of the quilt is greater than 72" (More than 60% of quilt design must be appliqué)
- 400 Medium Appliquéd, the longest side of the quilt is less than 72" and greater than 42" (More than 60% of the design must be appliqué)
- 500 Wall hanging, no side greater than 42"
- 600 Art Quilt, any size, includes embroidery and embellished quilts
- 700 Group/Friendship, any quilt made by more than 3 people
- 800 Miniatures, no side greater than 24", must represent a full sized quilt
- 900 Kits: quilts made from a kit that provided the fabrics and pattern
- WA Wearable, any quilted item such as a jacket, skirt or purse
- OT Other, all other quilts including table runners, and baby quilts
- CH Challenge quilt, Perimeter no greater than 120", Theme, Sweet Sixteen, totally made by the entrant.
- KQ Quilts made by children under the age of 16, top must be completed by the child. Indicate age on the label.

RIBBONS

For each category there may be 3 ribbons awarded, 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place. These will be determined by the judge for that category.

There will be 5 special awards given:

Best of show	determined by the 3 judges
Best new quilter	determined by the 3 judges
Best machine quilting	determined by the 3 judges
Best hand quilting	determined by the 3 judges
Viewers Choice	chosen by the viewers during the show

Black Canyon Quilt Show Inc. reserves the right to change the category that you enter in, if you have selected the wrong category.

Quilt Sleeve



1. Cut strip of fabric 8" wide and as long as your quilt is wide.
2. Make narrow hem at each short end.
3. Sew into long tube using 1/4" seam.
4. Turn and press with seam at bottom.
5. Press a good hard crease at top.
6. Turn tube down from top crease and press another crease 1" below top crease. (This crease will be your stitch line for top of sleeve.)

To Attach to Quilt:

1. Place sleeve so the top crease is just inside edge of binding along top of quilt and the 1" crease is next to the quilt (hidden).
2. Pin in place.
3. Sew bottom of sleeve to lining with blind stitches.
4. Fold down from top crease to the 1" crease and stitch in place.
